III. Proceeding items

a) Up gradation of Laboratories as per JNTUA R-15 and R-19 regulations

Resolution No. 2: After scrutinising the revised Curriculum and discussions, it is resolved to recommend to establish the new laboratories and upgrade the existing laboratories to meet the curriculum requirements as recommended by JNTUA R-15 and R19 regulations for the Even semester of Academic year 2019-20.

b) NAAC & NBA Accreditation process for GIST - Fixing of deadlines

Resolution No. 3: After deliberating on various related issues, it is resolved to recommend that,

- Institutional registration and submission of IIQA for NAAC accreditation for the institution shall be done during December 2019. Preparations for NBA shall be done immediately after submission of SSR for NAAC. The institution shall apply for NBA accreditation during the odd semester of 2019-20.
- 2. Training sessions and Workshops shall be conducted for staff members on NAAC and NBA accreditation procedures. They shall also be allowed to visit few reputed and accredited colleges for getting first hand exposure of the process
- 3. Teams shall be formed with staff members to attend the accreditation work of NAAC and NBA preparation.

c) Vacancies in senior teaching positions

Resolution No. 4: After assessing the existing faculty cadre ratios at the institution in all the Departments, it was observed AICTE norms were not satisfied. As the faculty cadre ratio is a major criteria for NAAC and NBA,

It is resolved to recommend that senior faculty members with Ph.D., qualifications shall be interviewed and appointed in all the Departments as per the AICTE norms

d. Audited Accounts statement

The audited statement of accounts of the Institution for the Financial Year 2018-2019 is placed before the Board. After reviewing the details, all the members acknowledged the procedure followed and appreciated the Finance Committee for precise submission of accounts for auditing. The proposal has been widely encouraged and all the items were approved by the members.

e.Medical Leave:

Resolution No. 5:The Medical leave for 8 full days (inclusive of interposed holidays) with full pay in calendar year shall be granted to all the confirmed staff members who undergo surgeries or get hospitalized for medical emergencies.

f) Financial assistance and incentive to faculty
