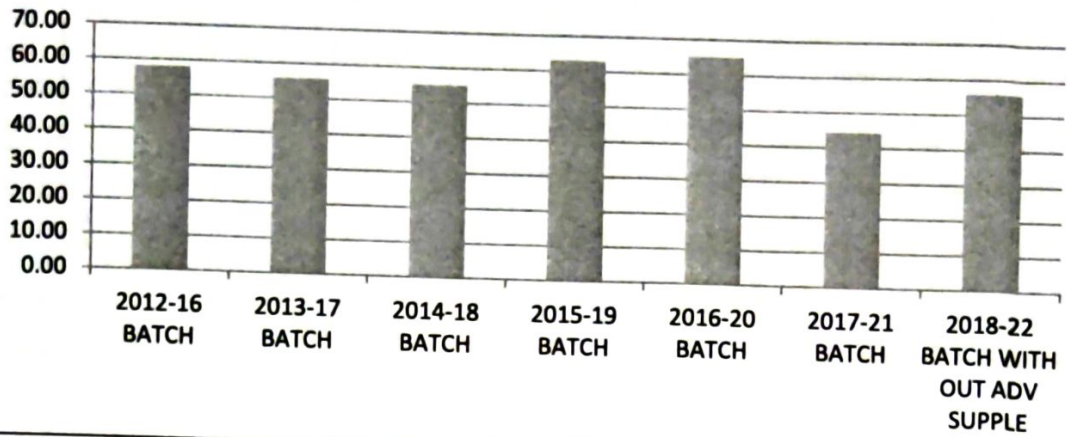

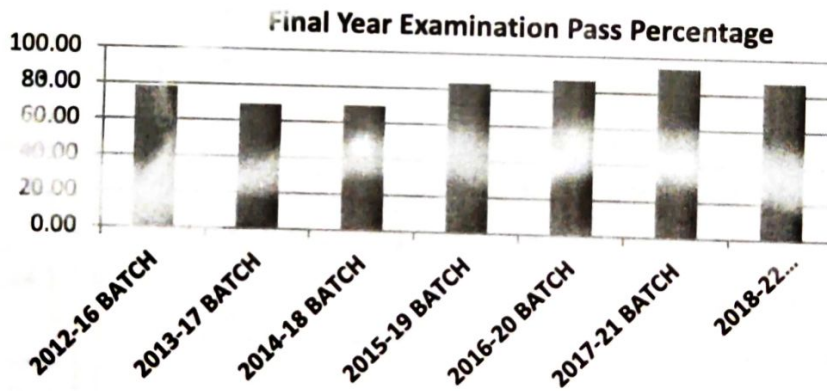

- Conduct seminars and group discussion to improve communication skills of students.


Dr.G.Subba Rao said that
