
Prof. S. Narayana Reddy suggested the following measures to improve academics:




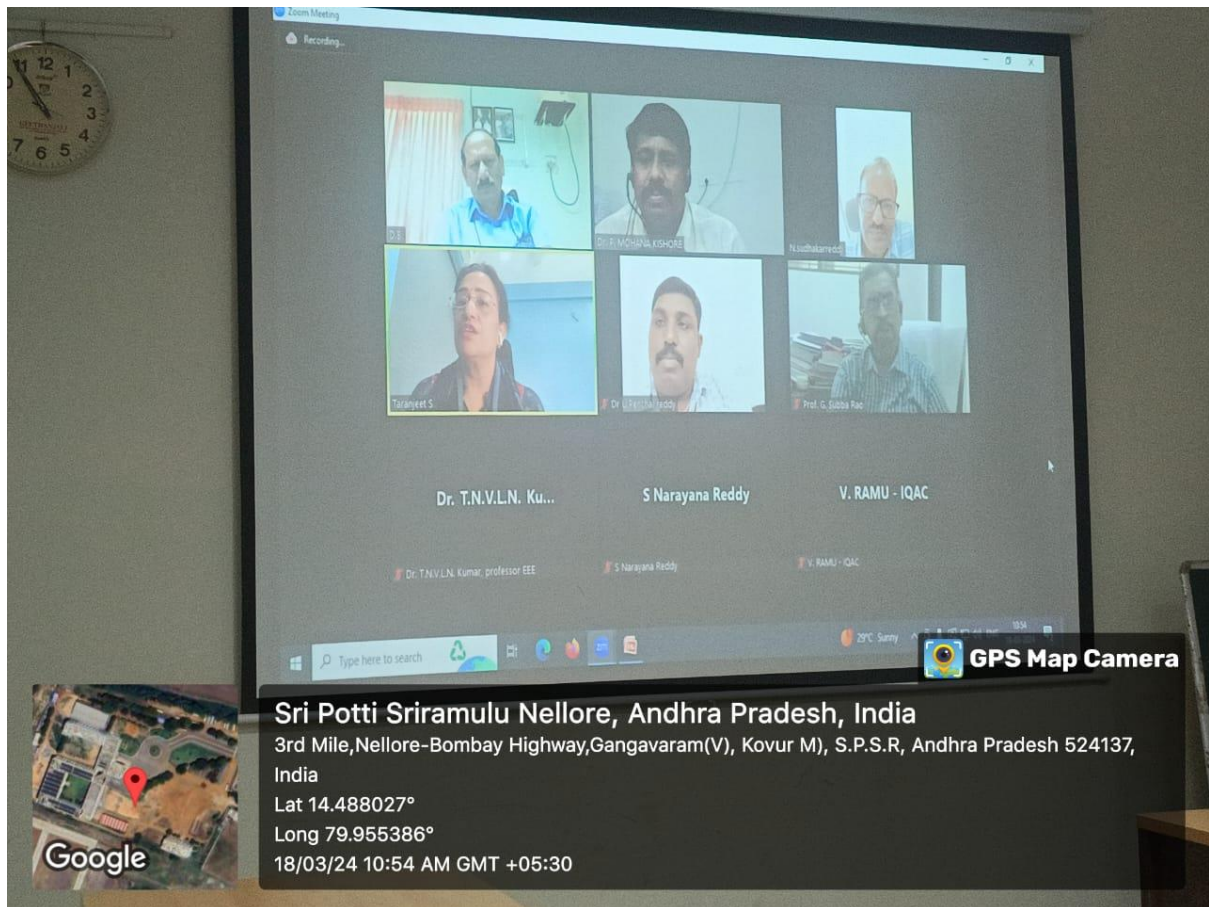
